The Arts, Culture and Entertainment Signals Team has been meeting monthly, using the Bay Area Arts and Culture Alliance https://greenbayart.org/ Spark GGB! report to better understand the current state of the arts, culture and entertainment in our region.

Spark GGB! Creating Our Future https://greenbayart.org/spark-ggb/ was designed to ignite the potential for the creative sector to give Greater Green Bay more vitality and vibrancy. The Bay Area Arts and Culture Alliance looked at what's already happened (within the sector and across other sectors such as business, health, education, public), sought opportunities to make it better, and began imagining a future with an even stronger creative Greater Green Bay.

The Arts, Culture and Entertainment Signals Team started with the information in the report. In our meetings, we discuss how best to scan or search for signals that are occurring globally, nation-wide and regionally.
